“MPD Obtains Assistance from the US Marshals Service”

The Moorhead Police Department continues to seek the public’s help with any information as to the whereabouts of Tracy Alan Zornes (38 yrs old). He is considered “a person of interest” in the Homicide Investigation regarding the deaths of John Phillip Cadotte and Megan Joy Londo on February 19th in South Moorhead. Tracy Zornes has outstanding Felony Warrants for his arrest for Probation Violation of prior crimes of 1st Degree Burglary & 1st Degree D.U.I. Zornes has an extensive criminal history and has demonstrated that he is willing to flee from the police.

We recently requested and obtained the assistance of the US Marshals Service, Minneapolis Office, to aid in the search. The US Marshals Service has an outstanding reputation in locating and apprehending dangerous felony fugitives. We are very pleased to have acquired their assistance in this investigation.
